

Requesting a TRADOC Analysis Center Model (non-U.S.inquiries)

There are two approaches.

- 1.) The foreign government should submit a request to the Deputy Undersecretary of the Army, Operations Research at

The request should identify which model, briefly describe the intended use of the model and identify the organization or organizations which will use it if provided.

If the requesting government can identify any existing International Agreement, Data Exchange Agreement, or Information Exchange Agreement which might be interpreted to allow transfer of the model, noting it in the request may help speed the process.

The DUSA-OR office will coordinate with TRAC. If release of the model is approved, TRAC will follow the Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) regulation 5-11 and develop an administrative agreement between TRAC and the receiving country.

- 2.) The foreign government may ask to purchase the model through the Foreign Military Sales (FMS) system. A request for price and availability should be sent to

This request should identify the model desired, the U.S. agency which controls the model, and identify the organization or organizations which will use it if provided. USASAC has many agencies to coordinate with, including TRAC, before a final decision on the release can be made.
